#### Here are ways your donations have helped:



The da Vinci Xi robot - our largest project was raising £1.675m to purchase the latest da Vinci Xi robot. The robot performs minimally invasive surgeries for cancer patients, allowing a faster recovery time.

Children's distraction toys, arts and craft - we supply all the craft and play for every children's ward, and provide distraction bags for children in A&E to help alleviate stress and worry.




**RITA technology** - interactive screens for the elderly and dementia patients to keep them engaged, encouraging interaction with others, and combatting loneliness and isolation.

**Ultrasound monitors** - enable parents to see their baby at the same time as the sonographer. This allows them to have more involvement in their scans.



**Christmas presents** - we provide every patient in our hospitals with a present on Christmas day, making sure no patient feels alone or isolated.
